- All speakers will be required to submit a MS PowerPoint presentation, in the proper format and by the deadlines established, for distribution in the conference proceedings.
- Commercialism guidelines, which restrict the use of trade names or material of a commercial or marketing nature, must be followed.
- Only new and original presentations will be considered.
- Copyright for INDA and AATCC to distribute each presentation must be supplied with a minimum of a one-time distribution basis, in accordance with the information that will be distributed with the speaker kits after paper acceptance.
- Presentations are limited to 20-25 minutes in length, with an additional 5 minutes for audience questions.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES:

Abstracts must be in English, no more than 300 words (less than one typed paged), and must include the following information: author name, job title, company affiliation, and contact information (phone, fax, and e-mail). The text of the abstract should contain information on the relationship of the research to an end-use product or a practical application in the nonwovens industry, a brief description of the topic or research methods, and what value the results have to the product or to the nonwovens industry.
